JESUS Prayer for His Disciples

John 17

These words spake Jesus, and lifted up his eyes to heaven, and said, Father, the hour is come; glorify thy Son, that thy Son also may glorify thee:

- 2) As thou hast given him power over all flesh, that he should give eternal life to as many as thou hast given him.
- 3) And this is life eternal, that they might know thee the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom thou hast sent.
- 4) I have glorified thee on the earth: I have finished the work which thou gavest me to do.
- 5) And now, O Father, glorify thou me with thine own self with the glory which I had with thee before the world was.
- 6) I have manifested thy name unto the men which thou gavest me out of the world: thine they were, and thou gavest them me; and they have kept thy word.
- 7) Now they have known that all things whatsoever thou hast given me are of thee.

- 8) For I have given unto them the words which thou gavest me; and they have received *them*, and have known surely that I came out from thee, and they have believed that thou didst send me.
- 9) I pray for them: I pray not for the world, but for them which thou hast given me; for they are thine.
- 10) And all mine are thine, and thine are mine; and I am glorified in them.
- 11) And now I am no more in the world, but these are in the world, and I come to thee. Holy Father, keep through thine own name those whom thou hast given me, that they may be one, as we *are*.
- 12) While I was with them in the world, I kept them in thy name: those that thou gavest me I have kept, and none of them is lost, but the son of perdition; that the scripture might be fulfilled.
- 13) And now come I to thee; and these things I speak in the world, that they might have my joy fulfilled in themselves.
- 14) I have given them thy word; and the world hath hated them, because they are not of the world, even as I am not of the world.
- 15) I pray not that thou shouldest take them out of the world, but that thou shouldest keep them from the evil.

- 16) They are not of the world, even as I am not of the world.
- 17) Sanctify them through thy truth: thy word is truth.
- 18) As thou hast sent me into the world, even so have I also sent them into the world.
- 19) And for their sakes I sanctify myself, that they also might be sanctified through the truth.
- 20) Neither pray I for these alone, but for them also which shall believe on me through their word;
- 21) That they all may be one; as thou, Father, *art* in me, and I in thee, that they also may be one in us: that the world may believe that thou hast sent me.
- 22) And the glory which thou gavest me I have given them; that they may be one, even as we are one:
- 23) I in them, and thou in me, that they may be made perfect in one; and that the world may know that thou hast sent me, and hast loved them, as thou hast loved me.
- 24) Father, I will that they also, whom thou hast given me, be with me where I am; that they may

behold my glory, which thou hast given me: for thou lovedst me before the foundation of the world.

- 25) O righteous Father, the world hath not known thee: but I have known thee, and these have known that thou hast sent me.
- 26) And I have declared unto them thy name, and will declare *it*: that the love wherewith thou hast loved me may be in them, and I in them.

Our Father Prayer

Matthew 6:9-15

After this manner therefore pray ye: Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name.

- 10) Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as *it is* in heaven.
- 11) Give us this day our daily bread.
- 12) And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors.
- 13) And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil: For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, for ever. Amen.
- 14) For if ye forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you:
- 15) But if ye forgive not men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.

The Prayer for Purpose and Time

Ecclesiastes 3

To every *thing there is* a season, and a time to every purpose under the heaven:

- 2) A time to be born, and a time to die; a time to plant, and a time to pluck up *that which is* planted;
- 3) A time to kill, and a time to heal; a time to break down, and a time to build up;
- 4) A time to weep, and a time to laugh; a time to mourn, and a time to dance;
- 5) A time to cast away stones, and a time to gather stones together; a time to embrace, and a time to refrain from embracing;
- 6) A time to get, and a time to lose; a time to keep, and a time to cast away;
- 7) A time to rend, and a time to sew; a time to keep silence, and a time to speak;
- 8) A time to love, and a time to hate; a time of war, and a time of peace.

The LORD Is My Shepherd

Psalm 23

The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want.

- 2) He maketh me to lie down in green pastures: he leadeth me beside the still waters.
- 3) He restoreth my soul: he leadeth me in the paths of righteousness for his name's sake.
- 4) Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil: for thou *art* with me; thy rod and thy staff they comfort me.
- 5) Thou preparest a table before me in the presence of mine enemies: thou anointest my head with oil; my cup runneth over.
- 6) Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life: and I will dwell in the house of the LORD for ever.

Dwelling in the Secret Place

Psalm 91

He that dwelleth in the secret place of the most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty.

- 2) I will say of the LORD, *He is* my refuge and my fortress: my God; in him will I trust.
- 3) Surely he shall deliver thee from the snare of the fowler, *and* from the noisome pestilence.
- 4) He shall cover thee with his feathers, and under his wings shalt thou trust: his truth *shall be thy* shield and buckler.
- 5) Thou shalt not be afraid for the terror by night; *nor* for the arrow *that* flieth by day;
- 6) *Nor* for the pestilence *that* walketh in darkness; *nor* for the destruction *that* wasteth at noonday.
- 7) A thousand shall fall at thy side, and ten thousand at thy right hand; *but* it shall not come nigh thee.
- 8) Only with thine eyes shalt thou behold and see the reward of the wicked.

- 9) Because thou hast made the LORD, which is my refuge, even the most High, thy habitation;
- 10) There shall no evil befall thee, neither shall any plague come night hy dwelling.
- 11) For he shall give his angels charge over thee, to keep thee in all thy ways.
- 12) They shall bear thee up in *their* hands, lest thou dash thy foot against a stone.
- 13) Thou shalt tread upon the lion and adder: the young lion and the dragon shalt thou trample under feet.
- 14) Because he hath set his love upon me, therefore will I deliver him: I will set him on high, because he hath known my name.
- 15) He shall call upon me, and I will answer him: I *will be* with him in trouble; I will deliver him, and honour him.
- 16) With long life will I satisfy him, and shew him my salvation.

The Prayers of Jabez

1 Chronicles 4:9, 10

And Jabez was more honourable than his brethren: and his mother called his name Jabez, saying, Because I bare him with sorrow.

10) And Jabez called on the God of Israel, saying, Oh that thou wouldest bless me indeed, and enlarge my coast, and that thine hand might be with me, and that thou wouldest keep *me* from evil, that it may not grieve me! And God granted him that which he requested.

The LORD is My Light I Shall Not Fear

Psalm 27

The LORD *is* my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? the LORD *is* the strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?

- 2) When the wicked, *even* mine enemies and my foes, came upon me to eat up my flesh, they stumbled and fell.
- 3) Though an host should encamp against me, my heart shall not fear: though war should rise against me, in this *will* I *be* confident.
- 4) One *thing* have I desired of the LORD, that will I seek after; that I may dwell in the house of the LORD all the days of my life, to behold the beauty of the LORD, and to enquire in his temple.
- 5) For in the time of trouble he shall hide me in his pavilion: in the secret of his tabernacle shall he hide me; he shall set me up upon a rock.
- 6) And now shall mine head be lifted up above mine enemies round about me: therefore will I offer in his tabernacle sacrifices of joy; I will sing, yea, I will sing praises unto the LORD.

- 7) Hear, O LORD, *when* I cry with my voice: have mercy also upon me, and answer me.
- 8) When thou saidst, Seek ye my face; my heart said unto thee, Thy face, LORD, will I seek.
- 9) Hide not thy face *far* from me; put not thy servant away in anger: thou hast been my help; leave me not, neither forsake me, O God of my salvation.
- 10) When my father and my mother forsake me, then the LORD will take me up.
- 11) Teach me thy way, O LORD, and lead me in a plain path, because of mine enemies.
- 12) Deliver me not over unto the will of mine enemies: for false witnesses are risen up against me, and such as breathe out cruelty.
- 13) *I had fainted*, unless I had believed to see the goodness of the LORD in the land of the living.
- 14) Wait on the LORD: be of good courage, and he shall strengthen thine heart: wait, I say, on the LORD.

Praise Ye the LORD

Psalm 150

Praise ye the LORD. Praise God in his sanctuary: praise him in the firmament of his power.

- 2) Praise him for his mighty acts: praise him according to his excellent greatness.
- 3) Praise him with the sound of the trumpet: praise him with the psaltery and harp.
- 4) Praise him with the timbrel and dance: praise him with stringed instruments and organs.
- 5) Praise him upon the loud cymbals: praise him upon the high sounding cymbals.
- 6) Let every thing that hath breath praise the LORD. Praise ye the LORD.

Prayer of a Coming Savior

Isaiah 53

Who hath believed our report? and to whom is the arm of the LORD revealed?

- 2) For he shall grow up before him as a tender plant, and as a root out of a dry ground: he hath no form nor comeliness; and when we shall see him, *there is* no beauty that we should desire him.
- 3) He is despised and rejected of men; a man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief: and we hid as it were *our* faces from him; he was despised, and we esteemed him not.
- 4) Surely he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted.
- 5) But he *was* wounded for our transgressions, *he* was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed.
- 6) All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and the LORD hath laid on him the iniquity of us all.

- 7) He was oppressed, and he was afflicted, yet he opened not his mouth: he is brought as a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before her shearers is dumb, so he openeth not his mouth.
- 8) He was taken from prison and from judgment: and who shall declare his generation? for he was cut off out of the land of the living: for the transgression of my people was he stricken.
- 9) And he made his grave with the wicked, and with the rich in his death; because he had done no violence, neither *was any* deceit in his mouth.
- 10) Yet it pleased the LORD to bruise him; he hath put *him* to grief: when thou shalt make his soul an offering for sin, he shall see *his* seed, he shall prolong *his* days, and the pleasure of the LORD shall prosper in his hand.
- 11) He shall see of the travail of his soul, *and* shall be satisfied: by his knowledge shall my righteous servant justify many; for he shall bear their iniquities.
- 12) Therefore will I divide him *a portion* with the great, and he shall divide the spoil with the strong; because he hath poured out his soul unto death: and he was numbered with the transgressors; and he bare the sin of many, and made intercession for the transgressors.

Before I Lay To Sleep

Psalm 4

Hear me when I call, O God of my righteousness: thou hast enlarged me *when I was* in distress; have mercy upon me, and hear my prayer.

- 2) O ye sons of men, how long will ye turn my glory into shame? how long will ye love vanity, and seek after leasing? Selah.
- 3) But know that the LORD hath set apart him that is godly for himself: the LORD will hear when I call unto him.
- 4) Stand in awe, and sin not: commune with your own heart upon your bed, and be still. Selah.
- 5) Offer the sacrifices of righteousness, and put your trust in the LORD.
- 6) *There be* many that say, Who will shew us *any* good? LORD, lift thou up the light of thy countenance upon us.
- 7) Thou hast put gladness in my heart, more than in the time *that* their corn and their wine increased.
- 8) I will both lay me down in peace, and sleep: for thou, LORD, only makest me dwell in safety.

The LORD Is My Strength

Psalm 18

I will love thee, O LORD, my strength.

- 2) The LORD *is* my rock, and my fortress, and my deliverer; my God, my strength, in whom I will trust; my buckler, and the horn of my salvation, *and* my high tower.
- 3) I will call upon the LORD, who is worthy to be praised: so shall I be saved from mine enemies.
- 4) The sorrows of death compassed me, and the floods of ungodly men made me afraid.
- 5) The sorrows of hell compassed me about: the snares of death prevented me.
- 6) In my distress I called upon the LORD, and cried unto my God: he heard my voice out of his temple, and my cry came before him, *even* into his ears.
- 7) Then the earth shook and trembled; the foundations also of the hills moved and were shaken, because he was wroth.
- 8) There went up a smoke out of his nostrils, and fire out of his mouth devoured: coals were kindled by it.

- 9) He bowed the heavens also, and came down: and darkness *was* under his feet.
- 10) And he rode upon a cherub, and did fly: yea, he did fly upon the wings of the wind.
- 11) He made darkness his secret place; his pavilion round about him *were* dark waters *and* thick clouds of the skies.
- 12) At the brightness *that was* before him his thick clouds passed, hail *stones* and coals of fire.
- 13) The LORD also thundered in the heavens, and the Highest gave his voice; hail *stones* and coals of fire.
- 14) Yea, he sent out his arrows, and scattered them; and he shot out lightnings, and discomfited them.
- 15) Then the channels of waters were seen, and the foundations of the world were discovered at thy rebuke, O LORD, at the blast of the breath of thy nostrils.
- 16) He sent from above, he took me, he drew me out of many waters.
- 17) He delivered me from my strong enemy, and from them which hated me: for they were too strong for me.

- 18) They prevented me in the day of my calamity: but the LORD was my stay.
- 19) He brought me forth also into a large place; he delivered me, because he delighted in me.
- 20) The LORD rewarded me according to my righteousness; according to the cleanness of my hands hath he recompensed me.
- 21) For I have kept the ways of the LORD, and have not wickedly departed from my God.
- 22) For all his judgments *were* before me, and I did not put away his statutes from me.
- 23) I was also upright before him, and I kept myself from mine iniquity.
- 24) Therefore hath the LORD recompensed me according to my righteousness, according to the cleanness of my hands in his eye sight.
- 25) With the merciful thou wilt shew thyself merciful; with an upright man thou wilt shew thyself upright;
- 26) With the pure thou wilt shew thyself pure; and with the froward thou wilt shew thyself froward.
- 27 For thou wilt save the afflicted people; but wilt bring down high looks.

- 28) For thou wilt light my candle: the LORD my God will enlighten my darkness.
- 29) For by thee I have run through a troop; and by my God have I leaped over a wall.
- 30) As for God, his way is perfect: the word of the LORD is tried: he is a buckler to all those that trust in him.
- 31) For who *is* God save the LORD? or who *is* a rock save our God?
- 32) *It is* God that girdeth me with strength, and maketh my way perfect.
- 33) He maketh my feet like hinds' *feet*, and setteth me upon my high places.
- 34) He teacheth my hands to war, so that a bow of steel is broken by mine arms.
- 35) Thou hast also given me the shield of thy salvation: and thy right hand hath holden me up, and thy gentleness hath made me great.
- 36) Thou hast enlarged my steps under me, that my feet did not slip.

- 37) I have pursued mine enemies, and overtaken them: neither did I turn again till they were consumed.
- 38) I have wounded them that they were not able to rise: they are fallen under my feet.
- 39) For thou hast girded me with strength unto the battle: thou hast subdued under me those that rose up against me.
- 40) Thou hast also given me the necks of mine enemies; that I might destroy them that hate me.
- 41) They cried, but *there was* none to save *them: even* unto the LORD, but he answered them not.
- 42) Then did I beat them small as the dust before the wind: I did cast them out as the dirt in the streets.
- 43) Thou hast delivered me from the strivings of the people; *and* thou hast made me the head of the heathen: a people *whom* I have not known shall serve me.
- 44) As soon as they hear of me, they shall obey me: the strangers shall submit themselves unto me.
- 45) The strangers shall fade away, and be afraid out of their close places.

Feed My Lambs

- 46) The LORD liveth; and blessed *be* my rock; and let the God of my salvation be exalted.
- 47) *It is* God that avengeth me, and subdueth the people under me.
- 48) He delivereth me from mine enemies: yea, thou liftest me up above those that rise up against me: thou hast delivered me from the violent man.
- 49) Therefore will I give thanks unto thee, O LORD, among the heathen, and sing praises unto thy name.
- 50) Great deliverance giveth he to his king; and sheweth mercy to his anointed, to David, and to his seed for evermore.

The Prayer of a Grateful Mother, Hanna

1 Samuel 2:1-10

And Hannah prayed, and said, My heart rejoiceth in the LORD, mine horn is exalted in the LORD: my mouth is enlarged over mine enemies; because I rejoice in thy salvation.

- 2) *There is* none holy as the LORD: for *there is* none beside thee: neither *is there* any rock like our God.
- 3) Talk no more so exceeding proudly; let *not* arrogancy come out of your mouth: for the LORD *is* a God of knowledge, and by him actions are weighed.
- 4) The bows of the mighty men *are* broken, and they that stumbled are girded with strength.
- 5) *They that were* full have hired out themselves for bread; and *they that were* hungry ceased: so that the barren hath born seven; and she that hath many children is waxed feeble.
- 6) The LORD killeth, and maketh alive: he bringeth down to the grave, and bringeth up.
- 7) The LORD maketh poor, and maketh rich: he bringeth low, and lifteth up.

- 8) He raiseth up the poor out of the dust, *and* lifteth up the beggar from the dunghill, to set *them* among princes, and to make them inherit the throne of glory: for the pillars of the earth *are* the LORD'S, and he hath set the world upon them.
- 9) He will keep the feet of his saints, and the wicked shall be silent in darkness; for by strength shall no man prevail.
- 10) The adversaries of the LORD shall be broken to pieces; out of heaven shall he thunder upon them: the LORD shall judge the ends of the earth; and he shall give strength unto his king, and exalt the horn of his anointed.

My Help Comes From The LORD

Psalm 121

I will lift up mine eyes unto the hills, from whence cometh my help.

- 2) My help *cometh* from the LORD, which made heaven and earth.
- 3) He will not suffer thy foot to be moved: he that keepeth thee will not slumber.
- 4) Behold, he that keepeth Israel shall neither slumber nor sleep.
- 5) The LORD *is* thy keeper: the LORD *is* thy shade upon thy right hand.
- 6) The sun shall not smite thee by day, nor the moon by night.
- 7) The LORD shall preserve thee from all evil: he shall preserve thy soul.
- 8) The LORD shall preserve thy going out and thy coming in from this time forth, and even for evermore.

My Trust Is In The LORD

Psalm 31

In thee, O LORD, do I put my trust; let me never be ashamed: deliver me in thy righteousness.

- 2) Bow down thine ear to me; deliver me speedily: be thou my strong rock, for an house of defence to save me.
- 3) For thou *art* my rock and my fortress; therefore for thy name's sake lead me, and guide me.
- 4) Pull me out of the net that they have laid privily for me: for thou *art* my strength.
- 5) Into thine hand I commit my spirit: thou hast redeemed me. O LORD God of truth.
- 6) I have hated them that regard lying vanities: but I trust in the LORD.
- 7) I will be glad and rejoice in thy mercy: for thou hast considered my trouble; thou hast known my soul in adversities;
- 8) And hast not shut me up into the hand of the enemy: thou hast set my feet in a large room.

- 9) Have mercy upon me, O LORD, for I am in trouble: mine eye is consumed with grief, *yea*, my soul and my belly.
- 10) For my life is spent with grief, and my years with sighing: my strength faileth because of mine iniquity, and my bones are consumed.
- 11) I was a reproach among all mine enemies, but especially among my neighbours, and a fear to mine acquaintance: they that did see me without fled from me.
- 12) I am forgotten as a dead man out of mind: I am like a broken vessel.
- 13) For I have heard the slander of many: fear *was* on every side: while they took counsel together against me, they devised to take away my life.
- 14) But I trusted in thee, O LORD: I said, Thou *art* my God.
- 15) My times *are* in thy hand: deliver me from the hand of mine enemies, and from them that persecute me.
- 16) Make thy face to shine upon thy servant: save me for thy mercies' sake.

- 17) Let me not be ashamed, O LORD; for I have called upon thee: let the wicked be ashamed, *and* let them be silent in the grave.
- 18) Let the lying lips be put to silence; which speak grievous things proudly and contemptuously against the righteous.
- 19) *Oh* how great *is* thy goodness, which thou hast laid up for them that fear thee; *which* thou hast wrought for them that trust in thee before the sons of men!
- 20) Thou shalt hide them in the secret of thy presence from the pride of man: thou shalt keep them secretly in a pavilion from the strife of tongues.
- 21) Blessed *be* the LORD: for he hath shewed me his marvellous kindness in a strong city.
- 22) For I said in my haste, I am cut off from before thine eyes: nevertheless thou heardest the voice of my supplications when I cried unto thee.
- 23) O love the LORD, all ye his saints: *for* the LORD preserveth the faithful, and plentifully rewardeth the proud doer.
- 24) Be of good courage, and he shall strengthen your heart, all ye that hope in the LORD.

Daniel's Answered Prayer

Daniel 2:19-23

Then was the secret revealed unto Daniel in a night vision. Then Daniel blessed the God of heaven.

- 20) Daniel answered and said, Blessed be the name of God for ever and ever: for wisdom and might are his:
- 21) And he changeth the times and the seasons: he removeth kings, and setteth up kings: he giveth wisdom unto the wise, and knowledge to them that know understanding:
- 22) He revealeth the deep and secret things: he knoweth what *is* in the darkness, and the light dwelleth with him.
- 23) I thank thee, and praise thee, O thou God of my fathers, who hast given me wisdom and might, and hast made known unto me now what we desired of thee: for thou hast *now* made known unto us the king's matter.

Show Me Thy Way, LORD

Psalm 25

Unto thee, O LORD, do I lift up my soul.

- 2) O my God, I trust in thee: let me not be ashamed, let not mine enemies triumph over me.
- 3) Yea, let none that wait on thee be ashamed: let them be ashamed which transgress without cause.
- 4) Shew me thy ways, O LORD; teach me thy paths.
- 5) Lead me in thy truth, and teach me: for thou *art* the God of my salvation; on thee do I wait all the day.
- 6) Remember, O LORD, thy tender mercies and thy loving kindnesses; for they *have been* ever of old.
- 7) Remember not the sins of my youth, nor my transgressions: according to thy mercy remember thou me for thy goodness' sake, O LORD.
- 8) Good and upright *is* the LORD: therefore will he teach sinners in the way.
- 9) The meek will he guide in judgment: and the meek will he teach his way.

- 10) All the paths of the LORD *are* mercy and truth unto such as keep his covenant and his testimonies.
- 11) For thy name's sake, O LORD, pardon mine iniquity; for it *is* great.
- 12) What man *is* he that feareth the LORD? him shall he teach in the way *that* he shall choose.
- 13) His soul shall dwell at ease; and his seed shall inherit the earth.
- 14) The secret of the LORD *is* with them that fear him; and he will shew them his covenant.
- 15) Mine eyes *are* ever toward the LORD; for he shall pluck my feet out of the net.
- 16) Turn thee unto me, and have mercy upon me; for Lam desolate and afflicted.
- 17) The troubles of my heart are enlarged: *O* bring thou me out of my distresses.
- 18) Look upon mine affliction and my pain; and forgive all my sins.
- 19) Consider mine enemies; for they are many; and they hate me with cruel hatred.

Feed My Lambs

- 20) O keep my soul, and deliver me: let me not be ashamed; for I put my trust in thee.
- 21) Let integrity and uprightness preserve me; for I wait on thee.
- 22) Redeem Israel, O God, out of all his troubles.

Bow Down Thine Ear, LORD

Psalm 86

Bow down thine ear, O LORD, hear me: for I *am* poor and needy.

- 2) Preserve my soul; for I *am* holy: O thou my God, save thy servant that trusteth in thee.
- 3) Be merciful unto me, O Lord: for I cry unto thee daily.
- 4) Rejoice the soul of thy servant: for unto thee, O Lord, do I lift up my soul.
- 5) For thou, Lord, *art* good, and ready to forgive; and plenteous in mercy unto all them that call upon thee.
- 6) Give ear, O LORD, unto my prayer; and attend to the voice of my supplications.
- 7) In the day of my trouble I will call upon thee: for thou wilt answer me.
- 8) Among the gods *there is* none like unto thee, O Lord; neither *are there any works* like unto thy works.

- 9) All nations whom thou hast made shall come and worship before thee, O Lord; and shall glorify thy name.
- 10) For thou *art* great, and doest wondrous things: thou *art* God alone.
- 11) Teach me thy way, O LORD; I will walk in thy truth: unite my heart to fear thy name.
- 12) I will praise thee, O Lord my God, with all my heart: and I will glorify thy name for evermore.
- 13) For great *is* thy mercy toward me: and thou hast delivered my soul from the lowest hell.
- 14) O God, the proud are risen against me, and the assemblies of violent *men* have sought after my soul; and have not set thee before them.
- 15) But thou, O Lord, *art* a God full of compassion, and gracious, longsuffering, and plenteous in mercy and truth.
- 16) O turn unto me, and have mercy upon me; give thy strength unto thy servant, and save the son of thine handmaid.
- 17) Shew me a token for good; that they which hate me may see *it*, and be ashamed: because thou, LORD, hast holpen me, and comforted me.

The Prayer of Mercy, Hezekiah

2 king 20:3

I beseech thee, O LORD, remember now how I have walked before thee in truth and with a perfect heart, and have done *that which is* good in thy sight. And Hezekiah wept sore.

Truly My Soul Waits

Psalm 62

Truly my soul waiteth upon God: from him *cometh* my salvation.

- 2) He only *is* my rock and my salvation; *he is* my defence; I shall not be greatly moved.
- 3) How long will ye imagine mischief against a man? ye shall be slain all of you: as a bowing wall *shall ye be, and as* a tottering fence.
- 4) They only consult to cast *him* down from his excellency: they delight in lies: they bless with their mouth, but they curse inwardly. Selah.
- 5) My soul, wait thou only upon God; for my expectation *is* from him.
- 6) He only *is* my rock and my salvation: *he is* my defence; I shall not be moved.
- 7) In God *is* my salvation and my glory: the rock of my strength, *and* my refuge, *is* in God.
- 8) Trust in him at all times; *ye* people, pour out your heart before him: God *is* a refuge for us. Selah.

Feed My Lambs

- 9) Surely men of low degree *are* vanity, *and* men of high degree *are* a lie: to be laid in the balance, they *are* altogether *lighter* than vanity.
- 10) Trust not in oppression, and become not vain in robbery: if riches increase, set not your heart *upon them*.
- 11) God hath spoken once; twice have I heard this; that power *belongeth* unto God.
- 12) Also unto thee, O Lord, *belongeth* mercy: for thou renderest to every man according to his work.

Thou Are My Shield

Psalm 3

LORD, how are they increased that trouble me! many *are* they that rise up against me.

- 2) Many *there be* which say of my soul, *There is* no help for him in God. Selah.
- 3) But thou, O LORD, *art* a shield for me; my glory, and the lifter up of mine head.
- 4) I cried unto the LORD with my voice, and he heard me out of his holy hill. Selah.
- 5) I laid me down and slept; I awaked; for the LORD sustained me.
- 6) I will not be afraid of ten thousands of people, that have set *themselves* against me round about.
- 7) Arise, O LORD; save me, O my God: for thou hast smitten all mine enemies *upon* the cheek bone; thou hast broken the teeth of the ungodly.
- 8) Salvation *belongeth* unto the LORD: thy blessing *is* upon thy people. Selah.

The Prayer in the Garden of Gethsemane

Mark 14:36

And he went forward a little, and fell on the ground, and prayed that, if it were possible, the hour might pass from him.

36) And he said, Abba, Father, all things *are* possible unto thee; take away this cup from me: nevertheless not what I will, but what thou wilt.

Luke 22:42

And he was withdrawn from them about a stone's cast, and kneeled down, and prayed,

- 42) Saying, Father, if thou be willing, remove this cup from me: nevertheless not my will, but thine, be done.
- 43) And there appeared an angel unto him from heaven, strengthening him.
- 44) And being in an agony he prayed more earnestly: and his sweat was as it were great drops of blood falling down to the ground.

Help Us LORD

Psalm 12

Help, LORD; for the godly man ceaseth; for the faithful fail from among the children of men.

- 2) They speak vanity every one with his neighbour: *with* flattering lips *and* with a double heart do they speak.
- 3) The LORD shall cut off all flattering lips, *and* the tongue that speaketh proud things:
- 4) Who have said, With our tongue will we prevail; our lips *are* our own: who *is* lord over us?
- 5) For the oppression of the poor, for the sighing of the needy, now will I arise, saith the LORD; I will set *him* in safety *from him that* puffeth at him.
- 6) The words of the LORD *are* pure words: *as* silver tried in a furnace of earth, purified seven times.
- 7) Thou shalt keep them, O LORD, thou shalt preserve them from this generation for ever.
- 8) The wicked walk on every side, when the vilest men are exalted.

Sing To The LORD

Psalm 149

Praise ye the LORD. Sing unto the LORD a new song, *and* his praise in the congregation of saints.

- 2) Let Israel rejoice in him that made him: let the children of Zion be joyful in their King.
- 3) Let them praise his name in the dance: let them sing praises unto him with the timbrel and harp.
- 4) For the LORD taketh pleasure in his people: he will beautify the meek with salvation.
- 5) Let the saints be joyful in glory: let them sing aloud upon their beds.
- 6) Let the high praises of God be in their mouth, and a two-edged sword in their hand;
- 7) To execute vengeance upon the heathen, *and* punishments upon the people;
- 8) To bind their kings with chains, and their nobles with fetters of iron;
- 9) To execute upon them the judgment written: this honour have all his saints. Praise ye the LORD.

Nehemiah's Prayer for GOD's People

Nehemiah 1:4:11

And it came to pass, when I heard these words, that I sat down and wept, and mourned *certain* days, and fasted, and prayed before the God of heaven,

- 5) And said, I beseech thee, O LORD God of heaven, the great and terrible God, that keepeth covenant and mercy for them that love him and observe his commandments:
- 6) Let thine ear now be attentive, and thine eyes open, that thou mayest hear the prayer of thy servant, which I pray before thee now, day and night, for the children of Israel thy servants, and confess the sins of the children of Israel, which we have sinned against thee: both I and my father's house have sinned.
- 7) We have dealt very corruptly against thee, and have not kept the commandments, nor the statutes, nor the judgments, which thou commandedst thy servant Moses.
- 8) Remember, I beseech thee, the word that thou commandedst thy servant Moses, saying, *If* ye transgress, I will scatter you abroad among the nations:

Feed My Lambs

- 9) But *if* ye turn unto me, and keep my commandments, and do them; though there were of you cast out unto the uttermost part of the heaven, *yet* will I gather them from thence, and will bring them unto the place that I have chosen to set my name there.
- 10) Now these *are* thy servants and thy people, whom thou hast redeemed by thy great power, and by thy strong hand.
- 11) O Lord, I beseech thee, let now thine ear be attentive to the prayer of thy servant, and to the prayer of thy servants, who desire to fear thy name: and prosper, I pray thee, thy servant this day, and grant him mercy in the sight of this man. For I was the king's cupbearer.

LORD, Save Me From Persecution

Psalm 7

O LORD my God, in thee do I put my trust: save me from all them that persecute me, and deliver me:

- 2) Lest he tear my soul like a lion, rending *it* in pieces, while *there is* none to deliver.
- 3) O LORD my God, if I have done this; if there be iniquity in my hands;
- 4) If I have rewarded evil unto him that was at peace with me; (yea, I have delivered him that without cause is mine enemy:)
- 5) Let the enemy persecute my soul, and take *it*; yea, let him tread down my life upon the earth, and lay mine honour in the dust. Selah.
- 6) Arise, O LORD, in thine anger, lift up thyself because of the rage of mine enemies: and awake for me *to* the judgment *that* thou hast commanded.
- 7) So shall the congregation of the people compass thee about: for their sakes therefore return thou on high.
- 8) The LORD shall judge the people: judge me, O LORD, according to my righteousness, and according to mine integrity *that is* in me.

- 9) Oh let the wickedness of the wicked come to an end; but establish the just: for the righteous God trieth the hearts and reins.
- 10) My defence *is* of God, which saveth the upright in heart.
- 11) God judgeth the righteous, and God is angry *with the wicked* every day.
- 12) If he turn not, he will whet his sword; he hath bent his bow, and made it ready.
- 13) He hath also prepared for him the instruments of death; he ordaineth his arrows against the persecutors.
- 14) Behold, he travaileth with iniquity, and hath conceived mischief, and brought forth falsehood.
- 15) He made a pit, and digged it, and is fallen into the ditch *which* he made.
- 16) His mischief shall return upon his own head, and his violent dealing shall come down upon his own pate.
- 17) I will praise the LORD according to his righteousness: and will sing praise to the name of the LORD most high.

Blessings In Trusting My LORD

Psalm 146

Praise ye the LORD. Praise the LORD, O my soul.

- 2) While I live will I praise the LORD: I will sing praises unto my God while I have any being.
- 3) Put not your trust in princes, *nor* in the son of man, in whom *there is* no help.
- 4) His breath goeth forth, he returneth to his earth; in that very day his thoughts perish.
- 5) Happy *is he* that *hath* the God of Jacob for his help, whose hope *is* in the LORD his God:
- 6) Which made heaven, and earth, the sea, and all that therein *is*: which keepeth truth for ever:
- 7) Which executeth judgment for the oppressed: which giveth food to the hungry. The LORD looseth the prisoners:
- 8) The LORD openeth *the eyes of* the blind: the LORD raiseth them that are bowed down: the LORD loveth the righteous:

- 9) The LORD preserveth the strangers; he relieveth the fatherless and widow: but the way of the wicked he turneth upside down.
- 10) The LORD shall reign for ever, *even* thy God, O Zion, unto all generations. Praise ye the LORD.

LORD, Who Am I?

2 Samuel 7:18

Then went king David in, and sat before the LORD, and he said, Who *am* I, O Lord GOD? and what *is* my house, that thou hast brought me hitherto?

- 19) And this was yet a small thing in thy sight, O Lord GOD; but thou hast spoken also of thy servant's house for a great while to come. And *is* this the manner of man, O Lord GOD?
- 20) And what can David say more unto thee? for thou, Lord GOD, knowest thy servant.
- 21) For thy word's sake, and according to thine own heart, hast thou done all these great things, to make thy servant know *them*.
- 22) Wherefore thou art great, O LORD God: for *there is* none like thee, neither *is there any* God beside thee, according to all that we have heard with our ears.
- 23) And what one nation in the earth *is* like thy people, *even* like Israel, whom God went to redeem for a people to himself, and to make him a name, and to do for you great things and terrible, for thy

land, before thy people, which thou redeemedst to thee from Egypt, *from* the nations and their gods?

- 24) For thou hast confirmed to thyself thy people Israel *to be* a people unto thee for ever: and thou, LORD, art become their God.
- 25) And now, O LORD God, the word that thou hast spoken concerning thy servant, and concerning his house, establish *it* for ever, and do as thou hast said.
- 26) And let thy name be magnified for ever, saying, The LORD of hosts *is* the God over Israel: and let the house of thy servant David be established before thee.
- 27) For thou, O LORD of hosts, God of Israel, hast revealed to thy servant, saying, I will build thee an house: therefore hath thy servant found in his heart to pray this prayer unto thee.
- 28) And now, O Lord GOD, thou *art* that God, and thy words be true, and thou hast promised this goodness unto thy servant:
- 29) Therefore now let it please thee to bless the house of thy servant, that it may continue for ever before thee: for thou, O Lord GOD, hast spoken *it*: and with thy blessing let the house of thy servant be blessed for ever.

Make Haste, Dear LORD

Psalm 70

Make haste, O God, to deliver me; make haste to help me, O LORD.

- 2) Let them be ashamed and confounded that seek after my soul: let them be turned backward, and put to confusion, that desire my hurt.
- 3) Let them be turned back for a reward of their shame that say, Aha, aha.
- 4) Let all those that seek thee rejoice and be glad in thee: and let such as love thy salvation say continually, Let God be magnified.
- 5) But I *am* poor and needy: make haste unto me, O God: thou *art* my help and my deliverer; O LORD, make no tarrying.

LORD, You Are Excellent!

Psalm 8

O LORD our Lord, how excellent *is* thy name in all the earth! who hast set thy glory above the heavens.

- 2) Out of the mouth of babes and sucklings hast thou ordained strength because of thine enemies, that thou mightest still the enemy and the avenger.
- 3) When I consider thy heavens, the work of thy fingers, the moon and the stars, which thou hast ordained;
- 4) What is man, that thou art mindful of him? and the son of man, that thou visitest him?
- 5) For thou hast made him a little lower than the angels, and hast crowned him with glory and honour.
- 6) Thou madest him to have dominion over the works of thy hands; thou hast put all *things* under his feet:
- 7) All sheep and oxen, yea, and the beasts of the field;
- 8) The fowl of the air, and the fish of the sea, *and* whatsoever passeth through the paths of the seas.

9) O LORD our Lord, how excellent *is* thy name in all the earth!

Lift Up Our LORD

Psalm 134

Behold, bless ye the LORD, all *ye* servants of the LORD, which by night stand in the house of the LORD.

- 2) Lift up your hands *in* the sanctuary, and bless the LORD.
- 3) The LORD that made heaven and earth bless thee out of Zion.

Prayer of Repentance, Ezra

Ezra 9:6-15

And said, O my God, I am ashamed and blush to lift up my face to thee, my God: for our iniquities are increased over *our* head, and our trespass is grown up unto the heavens.

- 7) Since the days of our fathers *have* we *been* in a great trespass unto this day; and for our iniquities have we, our kings, *and* our priests, been delivered into the hand of the kings of the lands, to the sword, to captivity, and to a spoil, and to confusion of face, as *it is* this day.
- 8) And now for a little space grace hath been *shewed* from the LORD our God, to leave us a remnant to escape, and to give us a nail in his holy place, that our God may lighten our eyes, and give us a little reviving in our bondage.
- 9) For we *were* bondmen; yet our God hath not forsaken us in our bondage, but hath extended mercy unto us in the sight of the kings of Persia, to give us a reviving, to set up the house of our God, and to repair the desolations thereof, and to give us a wall in Judah and in Jerusalem.
- 10) And now, O our God, what shall we say after this? for we have forsaken thy commandments,

- 11) Which thou hast commanded by thy servants the prophets, saying, The land, unto which ye go to possess it, is an unclean land with the filthiness of the people of the lands, with their abominations, which have filled it from one end to another with their uncleanness.
- 12) Now therefore give not your daughters unto their sons, neither take their daughters unto your sons, nor seek their peace or their wealth for ever: that ye may be strong, and eat the good of the land, and leave *it* for an inheritance to your children for ever.
- 13) And after all that is come upon us for our evil deeds, and for our great trespass, seeing that thou our God hast punished us less than our iniquities *deserve*, and hast given us *such* deliverance as this;
- 14) Should we again break thy commandments, and join in affinity with the people of these abominations? wouldest not thou be angry with us till thou hadst consumed *us*, so that *there should be* no remnant nor escaping?
- 15) O LORD God of Israel, thou *art* righteous: for we remain yet escaped, as *it is* this day: behold, we *are* before thee in our trespasses: for we cannot stand before thee because of this.

LORD, I Trust You

Psalm 11

In the LORD put I my trust: how say ye to my soul, Flee *as* a bird to your mountain?

- 2) For, lo, the wicked bend *their* bow, they make ready their arrow upon the string, that they may privily shoot at the upright in heart.
- 3) If the foundations be destroyed, what can the righteous do?
- 4) The LORD *is* in his holy temple, the LORD'S throne *is* in heaven: his eyes behold, his eyelids try, the children of men.
- 5) The LORD trieth the righteous: but the wicked and him that loveth violence his soul hateth.
- 6) Upon the wicked he shall rain snares, fire and brimstone, and an horrible tempest: *this shall be* the portion of their cup.
- 7) For the righteous LORD loveth righteousness; his countenance doth behold the upright.

Prayer for Mercy

Psalm 85

LORD, thou hast been favourable unto thy land: thou hast brought back the captivity of Jacob.

- 2) Thou hast forgiven the iniquity of thy people, thou hast covered all their sin. Selah.
- 3) Thou hast taken away all thy wrath: thou hast turned *thyself* from the fierceness of thine anger.
- 4) Turn us, O God of our salvation, and cause thine anger toward us to cease.
- 5) Wilt thou be angry with us for ever? wilt thou draw out thine anger to all generations?
- 6) Wilt thou not revive us again: that thy people may rejoice in thee?
- 7) Shew us thy mercy, O LORD, and grant us thy salvation.
- 8) I will hear what God the LORD will speak: for he will speak peace unto his people, and to his saints: but let them not turn again to folly.
- 9) Surely his salvation *is* nigh them that fear him; that glory may dwell in our land.

- 10) Mercy and truth are met together; righteousness and peace have kissed *each other*.
- 11) Truth shall spring out of the earth; and righteousness shall look down from heaven.
- 12) Yea, the LORD shall give *that which is* good; and our land shall yield her increase.
- 13) Righteousness shall go before him; and shall set *us* in the way of his steps.

GOD Is Great!

Psalm 145

I will extol thee, my God, O king; and I will bless thy name for ever and ever.

- 2) Every day will I bless thee; and I will praise thy name for ever and ever.
- 3) Great *is* the LORD, and greatly to be praised; and his greatness *is* unsearchable.
- 4) One generation shall praise thy works to another, and shall declare thy mighty acts.
- 5) I will speak of the glorious honour of thy majesty, and of thy wondrous works.
- 6) And *men* shall speak of the might of thy terrible acts: and I will declare thy greatness.
- 7) They shall abundantly utter the memory of thy great goodness, and shall sing of thy righteousness.
- 8) The LORD *is* gracious, and full of compassion; slow to anger, and of great mercy.
- 9) The LORD *is* good to all: and his tender mercies *are* over all his works.

- 10) All thy works shall praise thee, O LORD; and thy saints shall bless thee.
- 11) They shall speak of the glory of thy kingdom, and talk of thy power;
- 12) To make known to the sons of men his mighty acts, and the glorious majesty of his kingdom.
- 13) Thy kingdom *is* an everlasting kingdom, and thy dominion *endureth* throughout all generations.
- 14) The LORD upholdeth all that fall, and raiseth up all *those that be* bowed down.
- 15) The eyes of all wait upon thee; and thou givest them their meat in due season.
- 16) Thou openest thine hand, and satisfiest the desire of every living thing.
- 17) The LORD *is* righteous in all his ways, and holy in all his works.
- 18) The LORD *is* nigh unto all them that call upon him, to all that call upon him in truth.
- 19) He will fulfil the desire of them that fear him: he also will hear their cry, and will save them.
- 20) The LORD preserveth all them that love him: but all the wicked will he destroy.

21) My mouth shall speak the praise of the LORD: and let all flesh bless his holy name for ever and ever.

Blessed Are They

Matthew 5:2-12

And he opened his mouth, and taught them, saying,

- 3) Blessed *are* the poor in spirit: for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.
- 4) Blessed *are* they that mourn: for they shall be comforted.
- 5) Blessed *are* the meek: for they shall inherit the earth.
- 6) Blessed *are* they which do hunger and thirst after righteousness: for they shall be filled.
- 7) Blessed *are* the merciful: for they shall obtain mercy.
- 8) Blessed *are* the pure in heart: for they shall see God.
- 9) Blessed *are* the peacemakers: for they shall be called the children of God.
- 10) Blessed *are* they which are persecuted for righteousness' sake: for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

- 11) Blessed are ye, when *men* shall revile you, and persecute *you*, and shall say all manner of evil against you falsely, for my sake.
- 12) Rejoice, and be exceeding glad: for great *is* your reward in heaven: for so persecuted they the prophets which were before you.

<u>Prayer of Deliverance From Foolish</u> <u>Hearts</u>

Psalm 14

The fool hath said in his heart, *There is* no God. They are corrupt, they have done abominable works, *there is* none that doeth good.

- 2) The LORD looked down from heaven upon the children of men, to see if there were any that did understand, *and* seek God.
- 3) They are all gone aside, they are *all* together become filthy: *there is* none that doeth good, no, not one.
- 4) Have all the workers of iniquity no knowledge? who eat up my people *as* they eat bread, and call not upon the LORD.
- 5) There were they in great fear: for God *is* in the generation of the righteous.
- 6) Ye have shamed the counsel of the poor, because the LORD *is* his refuge.
- 7) Oh that the salvation of Israel *were come* out of Zion! when the LORD bringeth back the captivity of his people, Jacob shall rejoice, *and* Israel shall be glad.

Give us Help, LORD

Psalm 108

O God, my heart is fixed; I will sing and give praise, even with my glory.

- 2) Awake, psaltery and harp: I *myself* will awake early.
- 3) I will praise thee, O LORD, among the people: and I will sing praises unto thee among the nations.
- 4) For thy mercy *is* great above the heavens: and thy truth *reacheth* unto the clouds.
- 5) Be thou exalted, O God, above the heavens: and thy glory above all the earth;
- 6) That thy beloved may be delivered: save *with* thy right hand, and answer me.
- 7) God hath spoken in his holiness; I will rejoice, I will divide Shechem, and mete out the valley of Succoth.
- 8) Gilead *is* mine; Manasseh *is* mine; Ephraim also *is* the strength of mine head; Judah *is* my lawgiver;

- 9) Moab *is* my washpot; over Edom will I cast out my shoe; over Philistia will I triumph.
- 10) Who will bring me into the strong city? who will lead me into Edom?
- 11) Wilt not thou, O God, who hast cast us off? and wilt not thou, O God, go forth with our hosts?
- 12) Give us help from trouble: for vain *is* the help of man.
- 13) Through God we shall do valiantly: for he *it is that* shall tread down our enemies.

Thank you for Deliverance

Psalm 30

I will extol thee, O LORD; for thou hast lifted me up, and hast not made my foes to rejoice over me.

- 2) O LORD my God, I cried unto thee, and thou hast healed me.
- 3) O LORD, thou hast brought up my soul from the grave: thou hast kept me alive, that I should not go down to the pit.
- 4) Sing unto the LORD, O ye saints of his, and give thanks at the remembrance of his holiness.
- 5) For his anger *endureth but* a moment; in his favour *is* life: weeping may endure for a night, but joy *cometh* in the morning.
- 6) And in my prosperity I said, I shall never be moved.
- 7) LORD, by thy favour thou hast made my mountain to stand strong: thou didst hide thy face, *and* I was troubled.
- 8) I cried to thee, O LORD; and unto the LORD I made supplication.

- 9) What profit *is there* in my blood, when I go down to the pit? Shall the dust praise thee? shall it declare thy truth?
- 10) Hear, O LORD, and have mercy upon me: LORD, be thou my helper.
- 11) Thou hast turned for me my mourning into dancing: thou hast put off my sackcloth, and girded me with gladness;
- 12) To the end that my glory may sing praise to thee, and not be silent. O LORD my God, I will give thanks unto thee for ever.

Hear the Instructions, My Child

Proverbs 1:7-19

The fear of the LORD *is* the beginning of knowledge: *but* fools despise wisdom and instruction.

- 8) My son, hear the instruction of thy father, and forsake not the law of thy mother:
- 9) For they *shall be* an ornament of grace unto thy head, and chains about thy neck.
- 10) My son, if sinners entice thee, consent thou not.
- 11) If they say, Come with us, let us lay wait for blood, let us lurk privily for the innocent without cause:
- 12) Let us swallow them up alive as the grave; and whole, as those that go down into the pit:
- 13) We shall find all precious substance, we shall fill our houses with spoil:
- 14) Cast in thy lot among us; let us all have one purse:
- 15) My son, walk not thou in the way with them; refrain thy foot from their path:

- 16) For their feet run to evil, and make haste to shed blood.
- 17) Surely in vain the net is spread in the sight of any bird.
- 18) And they lay wait for their *own* blood; they lurk privily for their *own* lives.
- 19) So *are* the ways of every one that is greedy of gain; *which* taketh away the life of the owners thereof.

The LORD Is My Judge

Psalm 26

Judge me, O LORD; for I have walked in mine integrity: I have trusted also in the LORD; *therefore* I shall not slide.

- 2) Examine me, O LORD, and prove me; try my reins and my heart.
- 3) For thy lovingkindness *is* before mine eyes: and I have walked in thy truth.
- 4) I have not sat with vain persons, neither will I go in with dissemblers.
- 5) I have hated the congregation of evil doers; and will not sit with the wicked.
- 6) I will wash mine hands in innocency: so will I compass thine altar, O LORD:
- 7) That I may publish with the voice of thanksgiving, and tell of all thy wondrous works.
- 8) LORD, I have loved the habitation of thy house, and the place where thine honour dwelleth.
- 9) Gather not my soul with sinners, nor my life with bloody men:

- 10) In whose hands *is* mischief, and their right hand is full of bribes.
- 11) But as for me, I will walk in mine integrity: redeem me, and be merciful unto me.
- 12) My foot standeth in an even place: in the congregations will I bless the LORD.

The Earth Is the LORD's

Psalm 24

The earth *is* the LORD'S, and the fulness thereof; the world, and they that dwell therein.

- 2) For he hath founded it upon the seas, and established it upon the floods.
- 3) Who shall ascend into the hill of the LORD? or who shall stand in his holy place?
- 4) He that hath clean hands, and a pure heart; who hath not lifted up his soul unto vanity, nor sworn deceitfully.
- 5) He shall receive the blessing from the LORD, and righteousness from the God of his salvation.
- 6) This *is* the generation of them that seek him, that seek thy face, O Jacob. Selah.
- 7) Lift up your heads, O ye gates; and be ye lift up, ye everlasting doors; and the King of glory shall come in.
- 8) Who *is* this King of glory? The LORD strong and mighty, the LORD mighty in battle.

- 9) Lift up your heads, O ye gates; even lift *them* up, ye everlasting doors; and the King of glory shall come in.
- 10) Who is this King of glory? The LORD of hosts, he *is* the King of glory. Selah.

LORD, Hear Me!

Psalm 88

O LORD God of my salvation, I have cried day *and* night before thee:

- 2) Let my prayer come before thee: incline thine ear unto my cry;
- 3) For my soul is full of troubles: and my life draweth nigh unto the grave.
- 4) I am counted with them that go down into the pit: I am as a man *that hath* no strength:
- 5) Free among the dead, like the slain that lie in the grave, whom thou rememberest no more: and they are cut off from thy hand.
- 6) Thou hast laid me in the lowest pit, in darkness, in the deeps.
- 7) Thy wrath lieth hard upon me, and thou hast afflicted *me* with all thy waves. Selah.
- 8) Thou hast put away mine acquaintance far from me; thou hast made me an abomination unto them: *I am* shut up, and I cannot come forth.

- 9) Mine eye mourneth by reason of affliction: LORD, I have called daily upon thee, I have stretched out my hands unto thee.
- 10) Wilt thou shew wonders to the dead? shall the dead arise *and* praise thee? Selah.
- 11) Shall thy lovingkindness be declared in the grave? *or* thy faithfulness in destruction?
- 12) Shall thy wonders be known in the dark? and thy righteousness in the land of forgetfulness?
- 13) But unto thee have I cried, O LORD; and in the morning shall my prayer prevent thee.
- 14) LORD, why castest thou off my soul? Why hidest thou thy face from me?
- 15) I *am* afflicted and ready to die from *my* youth up: *while* I suffer thy terrors I am distracted.
- 16) Thy fierce wrath goeth over me; thy terrors have cut me off.
- 17) They came round about me daily like water; they compassed me about together.
- 18) Lover and friend hast thou put far from me, *and* mine acquaintance into darkness.

Whom My Soul Loves

Song of Solomon 3

By night on my bed I sought him whom my soul loveth: I sought him, but I found him not.

- 2) I will rise now, and go about the city in the streets, and in the broad ways I will seek him whom my soul loveth: I sought him, but I found him not.
- 3) The watchmen that go about the city found me: *to whom I said*, Saw ye him whom my soul loveth?
- 4) *It was* but a little that I passed from them, but I found him whom my soul loveth: I held him, and would not let him go, until I had brought him into my mother's house, and into the chamber of her that conceived me.
- 5) I charge you, O ye daughters of Jerusalem, by the roes, and by the hinds of the field, that ye stir not up, nor awake *my* love, till he please.
- 6) Who *is* this that cometh out of the wilderness like pillars of smoke, perfumed with myrrh and frankincense, with all powders of the merchant?
- 7) Behold his bed, which *is* Solomon's; threescore valiant men *are* about it, of the valiant of Israel.

- 8) They all hold swords, *being* expert in war: every man *hath* his sword upon his thigh because of fear in the night.
- 9) King Solomon made himself a chariot of the wood of Lebanon.
- 10) He made the pillars thereof *of* silver, the bottom thereof *of* gold, the covering of it *of* purple, the midst thereof being paved *with* love, for the daughters of Jerusalem.
- 11) Go forth, O ye daughters of Zion, and behold king Solomon with the crown wherewith his mother crowned him in the day of his espousals, and in the day of the gladness of his heart.

Prayer for Peace

Psalm 122

I was glad when they said unto me, Let us go into the house of the LORD.

- 2) Our feet shall stand within thy gates, O Jerusalem.
- 3) Jerusalem is builded as a city that is compact together:
- 4) Whither the tribes go up, the tribes of the LORD, unto the testimony of Israel, to give thanks unto the name of the LORD.
- 5) For there are set thrones of judgment, the thrones of the house of David.
- 6) Pray for the peace of Jerusalem: they shall prosper that love thee.
- 7) Peace be within thy walls, *and* prosperity within thy palaces.
- 8) For my brethren and companions' sakes, I will now say, Peace *be* within thee.
- 9) Because of the house of the LORD our God I will seek thy good.

LORD, Build Our House

Psalm 127

Except the LORD build the house, they labour in vain that build it: except the LORD keep the city, the watchman waketh *but* in vain.

- 2) *It is* vain for you to rise up early, to sit up late, to eat the bread of sorrows: *for* so he giveth his beloved sleep.
- 3) Lo, children *are* an heritage of the LORD: *and* the fruit of the womb *is his* reward.
- 4) As arrows *are* in the hand of a mighty man; so *are* children of the youth.
- 5) Happy *is* the man that hath his quiver full of them: they shall not be ashamed, but they shall speak with the enemies in the gate.

Sing To The LORD

Psalm 81

Sing aloud unto God our strength: make a joyful noise unto the God of Jacob.

- 2) Take a psalm, and bring hither the timbrel, the pleasant harp with the psaltery.
- 3) Blow up the trumpet in the new moon, in the time appointed, on our solemn feast day.
- 4) For this *was* a statute for Israel, *and* a law of the God of Jacob.
- 5) This he ordained in Joseph *for* a testimony, when he went out through the land of Egypt: *where* I heard a language *that* I understood not.
- 6) I removed his shoulder from the burden: his hands were delivered from the pots.
- 7) Thou calledst in trouble, and I delivered thee; I answered thee in the secret place of thunder: I proved thee at the waters of Meribah. Selah.
- 8) Hear, O my people, and I will testify unto thee: O Israel, if thou wilt hearken unto me;

- 9) There shall no strange god be in thee; neither shalt thou worship any strange god.
- 10) I am the LORD thy God, which brought thee out of the land of Egypt: open thy mouth wide, and I will fill it.
- 11) But my people would not hearken to my voice; and Israel would none of me.
- 12) So I gave them up unto their own hearts' lust: *and* they walked in their own counsels.
- 13) Oh that my people had hearkened unto me, *and* Israel had walked in my ways!
- 14) Should soon have subdued their enemies, and turned my hand against their adversaries.
- 15) The haters of the LORD should have submitted themselves unto him: but their time should have endured for ever.
- 16) He should have fed them also with the finest of the wheat: and with honey out of the rock should I have satisfied thee.

Blessed Be The LORD, Elizabeth

Luke 1:41-45

- 41) And it came to pass, that, when Elisabeth heard the salutation of Mary, the babe leaped in her womb; and Elisabeth was filled with the Holy Ghost:
- 42) And she spake out with a loud voice, and said, Blessed *art* thou among women, and blessed *is* the fruit of thy womb.
- 43) And whence *is* this to me, that the mother of my Lord should come to me?
- 44) For, lo, as soon as the voice of thy salutation sounded in mine ears, the babe leaped in my womb for joy.
- 45) And blessed *is* she that believed: for there shall be a performance of those things which were told her from the Lord.

Glory To GOD In The Highest

Luke 28:8-14

And there were in the same country shepherds abiding in the field, keeping watch over their flock by night.

- 9) And, lo, the angel of the Lord came upon them, and the glory of the Lord shone round about them: and they were sore afraid.
- 10) And the angel said unto them, Fear not: for, behold, I bring you good tidings of great joy, which shall be to all people.
- 11) For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Saviour, which is Christ the Lord.
- 12) And this *shall be* a sign unto you; Ye shall find the babe wrapped in swaddling clothes, lying in a manger.
- 13) And suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host praising God, and saying,
- 14) Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace, good will toward men.

Worthy Is the Lamb

Revelation 5:11-14

And I beheld, and I heard the voice of many angels round about the throne and the beasts and the elders: and the number of them was ten thousand times ten thousand, and thousands of thousands;

- 12) Saying with a loud voice, Worthy is the Lamb that was slain to receive power, and riches, and wisdom, and strength, and honour, and glory, and blessing.
- 13) And every creature which is in heaven, and on the earth, and under the earth, and such as are in the sea, and all that are in them, heard I saying, Blessing, and honour, and glory, and power, *be* unto him that sitteth upon the throne, and unto the Lamb for ever and ever.
- 14) And the four beasts said, Amen. And the four *and* twenty elders fell down and worshipped him that liveth for ever and ever.

Behold I Come

Revelation 22:12-17

And, behold, I come quickly; and my reward *is* with me, to give every man according as his work shall be.

- 13) I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end, the first and the last.
- 14) Blessed *are* they that do his commandments, that they may have right to the tree of life, and may enter in through the gates into the city.
- 15) For without *are* dogs, and sorcerers, and whoremongers, and murderers, and idolaters, and whosoever loveth and maketh a lie.
- 16) I Jesus have sent mine angel to testify unto you these things in the churches. I am the root and the offspring of David, *and* the bright and morning star.
- 17) And the Spirit and the bride say, Come. And let him that heareth say, Come. And let him that is athirst come. And whosoever will, let him take the water of life freely.

Luke 1:46-56

And Mary said, My soul doth magnify the Lord,

- 47) And my spirit hath rejoiced in God my Saviour.
- 48) For he hath regarded the low estate of his handmaiden: for, behold, from henceforth all generations shall call me blessed.
- 49) For he that is mighty hath done to me great things; and holy *is* his name.
- 50) And his mercy *is* on them that fear him from generation to generation.
- 51) He hath shewed strength with his arm; he hath scattered the proud in the imagination of their hearts.

- 53) He hath filled the hungry with good things; and the rich he hath sent empty away.
